## Weekly Storytime Programs:

**BABY SONGS & PLAY** (0-2 with caregiver): Songs and play time just for you and your little ones! Enjoy time together with other parents, caregivers, and babies to learn, play, and develop motor skills. Come prepared to sit on the floor and play with your baby and other caregivers. **No registration required.**

**SONG TIME FOR LITTLES** (ages 0-2 with a caregiver): A song session geared towards kids 0-2 for kids and caregivers! Songs, movement, and toys: lots of fun to be had while developing valuable early literacy skills. **No registration required.**

**TALES FOR TOTS** (ages 2-5 with a caregiver): A storytime geared towards kids 2-5 for kids and caregivers! Songs, movement, stories, activities and toytime: who could ask for anything more? **No registration required.**

**FAMILY STORYTIME** (ages 0-6 with a caregiver) We'll read books, sing songs, do movement, and play with toys in these storytimes for ages 0-6 with caregiver! **No registration is required.**

**STORYCRAFT** (ages 4-6): Kids listen to stories and create a craft based on a weekly theme. This program is for kids ages 4-6 and they attend the event on their own, while their caregiver remains present and available within the library. **Registration is required!**

## Special Programs:

**SNOWY DAY DROP-IN CRAFT:** Celebrate our Sunday opening with a drop-in Snowy Day craft in our Children's Room! We'll make our own torn paper crafts in the kid's room. No registration is required.

**SLIME WORKSHOP** (ages 6-12): Celebrate our Sunday opening by attending one of our slime workshops! Space is limited so be sure to register for a slot.

**SATURDAY STORYTIME:** Come to a special Saturday storytime at the library! We will be reading fun books, singing songs, and dancing along! No registration is required.

**DROP-IN FAMILY CRAFT:** Come to a special Holiday Break craft at the library! Craft time will be available from 11:00-12:00 as supplies last.

## Monthly & Bi-Weekly Programs:

**LITTLE HANDS ART CLUB** (18 months to 4 years with caregiver): In this monthly art class for young children, participants will listen to stories and create a process-based art project, developing key pre-literacy skills and creative expression. Librarians will lead a storytime and demo an art project, which caregivers will work together with their children to create. **Registration is required.**

**LEGO TIME** (recommended for ages 5 and up): Come use our Legos and Duplos to build some amazing Lego creations that we'll display around the library! All ages are welcome, but those under 10 years must be accompanied by a caregiver. **No registration required.**

**READ TO A THERAPY DOG** (children reading on their own): Sign up for a slot to read to Gurnet, a local yellow lab who is a certified therapy dog! Gurnet loves to listen to children read, and reading aloud can help improve comprehension and confidence. **Registration for a specific 15 minute time slot is required.**

**CREATIVITY CORNER (ages 6-8):** Come to a special monthly story and craft just for 6-8 year olds! We'll read stories and then do crafts and science. This special monthly program is for 6-8 year olds attending on their own, while their caregiver remains present and available within the library. **Registration is required!**

**YOUNG AUTHORS CLUB** (grades 4-6): Do you like to write stories? Have you ever wanted to write the script for a comic book or a movie? Come meet with other young writers at the Young Authors Club! We will be meeting on the second Thursday of every month from 4:30 to 5:30 pm to play writing games, learn tips and tricks, and work on writing projects together! **Registration is required.**

**TWEEN/TEEN WINTER PARTY** (grades 4-12): Celebrate the start of winter with us at the library! We'll have cookie decorating, crafts, games, and snacks. **Registration is required.**

**NOON YEAR'S EVE:** Too young to stay up until midnight? Ring in the new year in a new way! Celebrate at the library with hat making, dancing, and more. We'll count down to noon with crafts and fun. No registration is required for this event geared towards children and caregivers.
