Weekly Storytime Programs:

BABY SONGS & PLAY (0-2 with caregiver): Songs and play time just for you and your little ones! Enjoy time together with other parents, caregivers, and babies to learn, play, and develop motor skills. Come prepared to sit on the floor and play with your baby and other caregivers. **No registration required.**

SONG TIME FOR LITTLES (ages 0-2 with a caregiver): A song session geared towards kids 0-2 for kids and caregivers! Songs, movement, and toys: lots of fun to be had while developing valuable early literacy skills.
No registration required.

TALES FOR TOTS (ages 2-5 with a caregiver): A storytime geared towards kids 2-5 for kids and caregivers! Songs, movement, stories, activities and toytime: who could ask for anything more? **No registration required.**

FAMILY STORYTIME (ages 0-6 with a caregiver)
We'll read books, sing songs, do movement, and play with toys in these storytimes for ages 0-6 with caregiver! **No registration is required.**

STORYCRAFT (ages 4-6):
Kids listen to stories and create a craft based on a weekly theme. This program is for kids ages 4-6 and they attend the event on their own, while their caregiver remains present and available within the library. **Registration is required!**

February Vacation Week Programs:

COMIC BOOK CREATION SHOW: In this program, the audience helps invent a never-before-seen comic book! Using ideas from the crowd, Eric illustrates and tells the story of a brand new comic book hero, with a healthy dose of comedy throughout. Perfect for the budding artist as well as anyone who enjoys a good story and a laugh, this show appeals to all ages! We recommend this program for ages 4-12. Caregivers must accompany those under the age of 10. Registration is not required for this program which is free and open to the public!

IMPROV WORKSHOP FOR TEENS & TWEENS:
Improv Expert Eric Fulford will teach the basics of improv comedy to students in a fun, fast-paced workshop. They will begin with some warm-ups and move into more complicated games where students can create exciting stories and silly characters with each other! This workshop is for ages 9-18. Registration is required, as space is limited.

FAMILY MOVIE SCREENING: LEGO BATMAN (PG):
Enjoy a movie screening of family favorite LEGO Batman! **No registration required.**

Monthly & Bi-Weekly Programs:

LITTLE HANDS ART CLUB (18 months to 4 years with caregiver): In this monthly art class for young children, participants will listen to stories and create a process-based art project, developing key pre-literacy skills and creative expression. Librarians will lead a storytime and demo an art project, which caregivers will work together with their children to create. **Registration is required.**

LEGO TIME (recommended for ages 5 and up):
Come use our Legos and Duplos to build some amazing Lego creations that we'll display around the library! All ages are welcome, but those under 10 years must be accompanied by a caregiver. **No registration required.**

CREATIVITY CORNER (ages 6-8):
Come to a special monthly story and craft just for 6-8 year olds! We'll read stories and then do crafts and science. This special monthly program is for 6-8 year olds attending on their own, while their caregiver remains present and available within the library. **Registration is required!**

YOUNG AUTHORS CLUB (grades 4-6):
Do you like to write stories? Have you ever wanted to write the script for a comic book or a movie? Come meet with other young writers at the Young Authors Club! We will be meeting on the second Thursday of every month from 4:30 to 5:30 pm to play writing games, learn tips and tricks, and work on writing projects together! **Registration is required.**

TWEEN INTEREST GROUP
(grades 4-6):
TWIG is for children in grades 4-6 who love the library and want to help us plan our next big events, give input into what books we will add to our collection, and volunteer at library events. We'll do crafts, play games, eat snacks, and talk about what you'd like to see at the library. **Registration is required.**

February's meeting will be a Bad Art competition in tandem with TAG! Participants will work to create their own interpretation of bad art and vote on the best (worst) pieces! Snacks will be provided at the end of the program.
